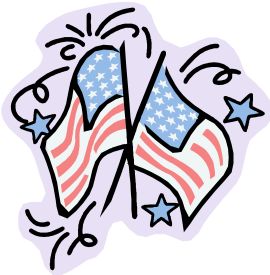

Borough Acquires Lucas Homestead!

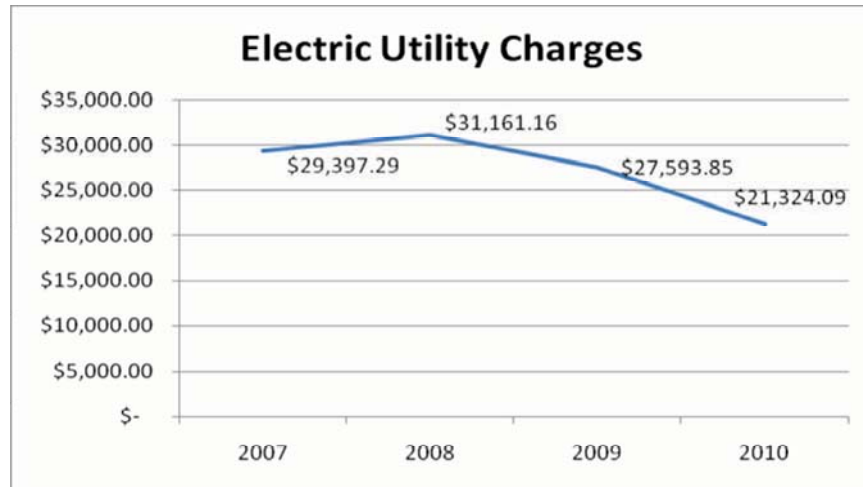


The summer home of 19th century industrialist John Lucas, built around 1849, is not the oldest structure in Gibbsboro but is the most significant. The “Homestead” was among John and Harriet Lucas’ favorite places and John contributed to American history from our town. Lucas was at the forefront of the industrialization of paint and color manufacturing, developing dozens of patents from his Gibbsboro labs. Among them was the first patent for “ready-mix” paint..... paint in a can!

The home was acquired by Gibbsboro for the value of a tax lien. Most of the Lucas family’s homes were destroyed when the Paint Works was redeveloped in the 1980s.

Conservation/ Electricity Savings News

Gibbsboro joined with dozens of New Jersey towns to solicit bids collectively electricity from various electric providers. Seven towns in the Atlantic City Electric (ACE) service area, including Gibbsboro will see approximately a 35% reduction in street lighting costs (over the ACE rate). For fixed electric Gibbsboro and seven other towns will enjoy a 31% discount! The bid is valid for one year at which time it will be re-competed.

On May 9 Gibbsboro sold eleven SRECs that had been accumulated from the town's solar generation facility at Pole Hill Park for \$7,133. SRECs are earned based upon the number of kilowatt –hours of energy produced and metered by a solar facility. The Borough's facility produces roughly enough energy to power the Senior Recreation facility and parking lot lights at Pole Hill Park.

Grant funded improvements in lighting and heating, ventilation, and air conditioning (HVAC) at the Pole Hill Park facility are being installed and will yield additional utility savings.

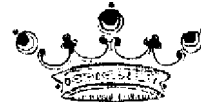
