## Visionary, Home Builder, Developer of the Paint Works Corporate Center

Mr. Scarborough died at his Collingswood home on April 21. Mr. Scarborough's affiliation with Gibbsboro was as the redeveloper of the former Sherwin Williams paint manufacturing plant centered on Silver Lake. The plant closed in 1978 and was purchased by Mr. Scarborough in 1981.

Mr. Scarborough served as a pilot during World War II and was the founder and owner of Bob Scarborough Inc. He was a member of the Haddonfield Rotary, the South Jersey Builders League and a former Board Member for over 30 years at West Jersey Hospital. A wing, the Scarborough Center for Women and children, was named after him.

Mr. Scarborough is survived by son Kevin and grandchildren Sean, Todd, Christopher, Lindsay, Douglas, and Jeffrey and great grandchildren Nathan, Lily and Jane.
